



Fort Point Trail Rehabilitation Project – Donation Pledge

The Town of St. George Conservation Commission has developed a plan to significantly improve the Fort Point trail. The proposed work will include a new footbridge and a completely upgraded trail. When completed, the trail will meet Universal Access (UA) standards, expanding access and allow for great hiking year-round.

The total cost of the rehabilitation is estimated at \$160,000. The Conservation Commission is applying for a Recreational Trails Program (RTP) grant from the State for the \$120,000 category. Current donations, pledges and Town contributions total \$34,000. This leaves us with a shortfall of \$6,000.

If you support this project and are able to help, your pledge now could help meet the grant required matching funds goal.
