## MAP 1: WETLAND RESOURCES

**Streams, Rivers, and Ponds**  
Mapped by state and federal agencies based on satellite imagery.

**NWI Wetlands**  
The U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service created the National Wetlands Inventory Program (NWI) in the 1970's to produce maps of U.S. wetlands to aid in natural resource planning and conservation. The maps show the general location, type, and configuration of wetlands that can be identified through conventional aerial photo interpretation techniques.

**High-Probability Wetlands**  
These areas are likely to be wetlands based on slope analysis, presence of hydric soils, and/or the drainage characteristics of the underlying soil.

**St. George Sub-Watersheds**  
Georges River  
Long Cove/Wheeler Bay  
Tenants Harbor  
Mosquito Harbor/Tenants Harbor  
Deep Cove

Watershed divides are derived from the National Hydrography Dataset and Watershed Boundary Dataset, both of which are U.S. Geological Survey projects. Sub-watersheds were later localized by the Maine Geological Survey. Islands are individual watersheds, and are not represented as part of any sub-watershed.
