This map is non-regulatory and is intended for planning purposes only.

- Permanently Conserved Lands**
- Georges River Land Trust or Maine Coast Heritage Trust
  - State, Federal and Other Organizations

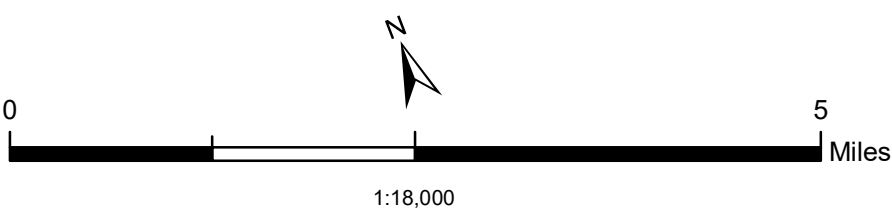
These properties are permanently protected through fee ownership or conservation easements. See Map 6 for properties that offer recreational access to the public.

- Tax-Code Protected Lands**
- Farmland
  - Open Space
  - Tree Growth
  - Working Waterfront

These properties are temporarily protected through local tax code programs. A parcel can be removed from these programs at any time with a fee, typically in the form of payment of property taxes waived during the enrollment time period.

- Semi-Protected Lands**
- Town of St. George
  - Tenants Harbor Water District
  - Nonprofit Organizations/Associations

These properties are temporarily protected based on their ownership and/or current use. A parcel may be sold at any time, however, altering its status. Nonprofit organizations and associations include churches, cemeteries, libraries, schools, and the St. George Historical Society.
