**Important Farmlands**  
Defined by the U.S. Department of Agriculture, these soils consist of prime farmland, unique farmland, and farmland of statewide or local importance. Prime farmland is land that has the best combination of physical and chemical characteristics for producing food, feed, forage, fiber, and oilseed crops and is available for these uses. Unique farmland is land other than prime farmland that is used for the production of specific high-value food and fiber crops. Soil types include Boothbay Silt Loam, Peru Fine Sandy Loam, and Tunbridge-Lyman Fine Sandy Loam.

**Poorly Drained Soils**  
Soil types include Biddeford Mucky Peat, Brayton Fine Sandy Loam, and Swanville Silt Loam.
