Old Business

- Survey Tim presented the survey drawing prepared by Gartley and Dorsky. The key aspect of the survey addresses the boundary between the Paulsen property and the Town property. The property line is primarily delineated by the rock wall that runs parallel to the north boundary that was established when the Spring Lane subdivision was planned. It was established that the current parking area did not encroach on the Paulsen property. Lori felt that the drawing fairly represented the proper boundary based on a recent discussion she had with Richie and Richard Paulsen. Lori thanked the committee for the work that has been done. Lori took the action to bring the drawing to discuss with Richard and Richie and get their approval or identify any issues to be addressed. Once there is agreement to the survey document, boundary line agreement documents will be prepared by the town office for filing.
- 2. Signage Appropriate signage to identify the direction to the Fort Point Trail and identifying Starboard Lane as a private way was discussed. The direction sign will be free standing and the Private Way sign can be added to the Starboard Lane street sign. It was agreed that the property boundary at the eastern end of the property would be done in an aesthetically pleasing manner using plantings with minimal signage. Sign design and boundary delineation will be coordinated with Lori.
- 3. Follow up with BPL- Ken said that there was nothing to report.
