ELIGIBILITY:

Candidates must be a permanent resident of the St. George Township, and must be attending an accredited high school or a private school or home school program or be a high school graduate.

AWARDS:

The Lighthouse Committee awards two four year scholarships of \$1000.00 for the first year of college, and \$ 500.00 for each of the next three years. Technical school/community college recipients will receive \$1000.00 for the first year and \$500.00 for the second year.

Applicants should answer all questions clearly and complete all requested information. Applications should include

1. A COMPLETED APPLICATION - FORM ATTACHED,
2. A HIGH SCHOOL OR EQUIVALENT EDUCATIONAL TRANSCRIPT,
3. A LETTER FROM YOUR COUNSELOR OR TEACHER REGARDING YOUR ACHIEVEMENTS AND CHARACTER.
4. A BRIEF ESSAY OR LETTER EXPLAINING YOUR GOALS FOR FURTHER EDUCATION, AND YOUR NEED FOR FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE.
