OLD BUSINESS

1. SENIORS REPORT: 33 attended the last luncheon and enjoyed the flutes. Next luncheon is scheduled for Thursday but a snow is expected. If so, will reschedule it to the following Thursday.
2. FINANCIAL REPORT: in line with percentages as it should be this time of year. Will be slightly in the black and have enough to cover.
3. ADULT PROGRAMS REPORT: Volleyball will continue on Monday nights in the gym. Basketball started up again last Thursday night in the gym and went well.

Wilgus will set it up for \$2400 including removal of old one + \$5400 cost + \$1900 shipping = \$9700.

A motion to "approve going forward with the Merry Go Round and let the Select Board know we will continue to research better cost/shipping options and total cost for project". Bryan 2nd, and all were in favor of the motion.
