### Fort Point Trail Closure

The Fort Point trail was closed as of May 1, 2023. This closure is out of concern for the safety of visitors during the construction phase of the Fort Point Trail Rehabilitation Project. We look forward to everyone enjoying the improvements later this summer.



### Construction Progress

Construction has finally begun. Kennebec Trail Company has started delivering materials to the site and doing the initial prep work for the bridge crossing over the stream. We expect the new bridge to be complete before the end of June. Full trail completion is expected by the end of the summer.
