Hunting Season

Fort Point Trail Rehabilitation Project

The Fort Point trail remains CLOSED during the construction phase of the project. This closure is out of concern for the safety of visitors and to allow for the work to proceed in an orderly manner.

Project Progress: Significant progress has been made over the last six weeks. The trail section on the State property at the “Point” has been completed including firm surfaces at three picnic table locations adjacent to the path. Approximately 1/3 of the access trail on the town property is now complete, including a short section of boardwalk.

Invasive Plants

Is this invasive plant choking out your tree?



Asiatic Bittersweet is a deciduous, woody vine that climbs up trees or sprawls over low-growing vegetation. It is considered a highly noxious invasive first brought in from Asia and sold as an ornamental.

The fall is a good time to spot this plant with its yellowing leaves and bright yellow-green berries. Many of us have seen the branches and berries woven into holiday wreaths. The plant is found throughout coastal Maine and the northeast. Drive around Saint George and you're sure to spot some, perhaps even in your yard.

As with all invasives Asiatic Bittersweet out-competes native plants and can easily take over an entire area. On trees it can cover the canopy and eventually kill the tree. It is extremely difficult to control and to eradicate. HONORING ALL THOSE WHO SERVED

2024 dog licenses are now available. The cost is \$11 for an “unaltered” dog, and \$6 for a dog “incapable of producing young.” (That’s state legal talk for “not fixed” and “fixed.”) Dogs must be licensed by January 31st of each year, or the state levies a pretty heavy \$25 late fee. Beat the rush, and license your dog now!

According to 7 MRS §3911, “it is unlawful for any dog, licensed or unlicensed, to be at large, except when used for hunting.” 7 MRS §3907 defines “at large” to be “off the premises of the owner and not under the control of any person whose personal presence and attention would reasonably control the conduct of the animal.”
